To become a Certified Instructor, you must:

1. Attend at least one Introduction to Flexible Bronchoscopy Program.
2. Attend at least one Train-the-Trainer program.
3. Participate as an Instructor in at least three regional, national, or international bronchoscopy training courses.
4. Demonstrate familiarity with Assessment tools, Checklists, 4-Box Practical Approach, and Bronchoscopy Step-by-Step.
5. Read all four books of the Essential Bronchoscopist Series.
6. Incorporate some or all Bronchoscopy International learning materials into your institution's training programs.
7. Actively promote learner-centric training and the use of competency-based teaching materials at the local, regional, national or international level.

To become a Master Instructor, you must:

1. Be a Certified Instructor.
2. Attend at least one Train-the-Trainer program.
3. Participate as an Instructor in at least three regional, national, or international courses that use Bronchoscopy International learning materials.
4. Participate as an Instructor in at least one Train-the-Trainer Program.
5. Be the Course Director of at least one Introduction to Flexible Bronchoscopy course and another Interventional Pulmonary program.
6. Participate in bronchoscopy education-related research or contribute to the design and implementation of bronchoscopy learning materials.
7. Demonstrate skill using Bronchoscopy International's learning materials, philosophies, and curricular structures at the local, regional, national, or international level.
